# 2022 Food Show General Rules & Guidelines

The 2022 Food Show will be in the Exhibit Hall at the Ardmore Convention Center on Friday, June 10th.

#### **Divisions:**

- Adult Division Any person who is out of high school may enter.
- **Junior Division** Any student through grade 12 may enter. Recent high school graduates will compete in the adult division

#### 2022 Food Show Categories and Classes:

#### Pies

- Class A: Standard (9-inch pie)
- Class B: Other- Chocolate, etc. (9-inch pie)

#### **Bread & Rolls**

- Class A: Quick- Loaf & Rolls (Standard Loaf/ 6 Rolls)
- Class B: Yeast- Loaf & Rolls (Standard Loaf/ 6 Rolls)

#### Candy

- Class A: Fudge (12 Pieces)
- Class B: Brittle, Pralines, & Divinity (12 Pieces)
- Class C: Other Pecan Candy (12 Pieces)

#### Cakes

- Class A: Without Frosting
- Class B: Frosted (with pecans in cake)

#### **Cookies**

- Class A: Drop
- Class B: Bar

#### Meats

- Class A: Spiced or Salted (1 cup)
- Class B: Candied (1 cup)

### **Specialty**

- Class A: Appetizers & Side Dishes
- Class B: Snacks
- Class C: Dessert

#### **General Rules:**

#### Entries

- All food entries must be prepared by the exhibitor.
- Entries will be accepted between 7:30 AM and 10:00 AM on Friday, June 10th. The entries must remain in place until 4:00 PM.
- All entries must be displayed in a disposable paper or aluminum container, covered with transparent wrapping. Pecan meats may be displayed in a plastic bag.
- If entry is awarded Grand Champion, the container will not be returned.

#### Recipes

- The recipe must accompany each entry. Recipes for pies should include crust and filling, recipes for frosted cakes should include cake and frosting, etc.
- The exhibitor's name must not appear anywhere on the recipe. Do not print the exhibitor's name on the back.
- Recipes became the property of the Oklahoma Pecan Growers Association.

#### • Pick Up

- The Grand Champion entry in each category will become the property of the Oklahoma Pecan Growers Association and will be auctioned off during the Awards Banquet on Friday evening, June 10th.
- Entries, other than Grand Champion, must be picked up from the Food Show between 4:00 PM 4:30 PM on Friday, June 10th.
- Entries not removed by 4:30 PM become the property of the Oklahoma Pecan Growers Association.

#### Awards:

• Grand Champions will be presented with the Pecan Show Awards. The Adult Grand Champions will be awarded a plaque; the Junior Grand Champions will be awarded a prize award. The awards will be presented at the Oklahoma Pecan Growers Association Awards Banquet.
